Benjamin Page is an innovative designer and passionate artist. He was trained in the disciplines of the Arts, Architecture and Design. In the past he has painted, drawn and sculpted, with most of his art in the earlier period of his life focused on self-expression and as reflections of his unique personal experiences.
